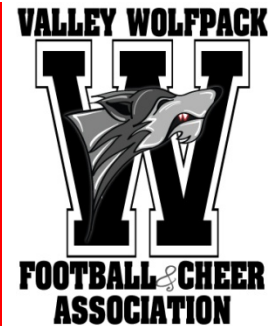

Coaches Corner!!
